On May 22, 2012, John D. Rood has been elected to the Fidelity National Financial, Inc. ("FNF" or the "Company") Board of Directors at its 2013 Annual Meeting of Shareholders. Mr. Rood will serve as Class I Director to serve until the 2015 FNF Annual Meeting of Shareholders, as set forth in the Company's Proxy Statement dated April 12, 2013.

Mr. Rood is the founder and Chairman of The Vestcor Companies, Inc., a real estate firm with 30 years of experience in multi-family housing development and investment. From 2004-2007, Mr. Rood served as the United States Ambassador to the Commonwealth of the Bahamas and from 1999-2004 he was appointed by Governor Jeb Bush to serve on the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.

Mr. Rood replaces General William Lyon, who has retired from the FNF Board of Directors after 15 years of service. Mr. Rood is 57 years old.
